



Browser Trouble-Shooting Guide

The most common browser issues and resolution that users may experience when using EPA SA WasteTracker.


Note, Internet Explorer is the recommended browser to use.



Internet Explorer


Problem:

Compatibility View: websites designed for older browsers will often look better, and problems such as out-of-place menus, images, or text will be corrected.



Resolution:


1. Left-click on the symbol  in the address bar:



and enable compatibility if mentioned in the pop up message.

OR

2. Select **Tools** then **Compatibility Settings** from browser menu in the top ribbon
3. Type in **sa.gov.au** and click **Add** then **Close**:



4. Refresh the WasteTracker page (F5) and login if necessary.

Problem:

Pop-up Blocker: Usually if nothing happens, for example, when printing a transport certificate, a prompt will appear at the top or bottom of the screen. Users can allow the pop-ups for this site and the browser will remember not to block pop-ups from WasteTracker.




Resolution:

1. Click on the “Always allow” option

OR

2. Select **Tools** then **Pop-up Blocker > Turn off Pop-up Blocker** from browser menu in the top ribbon
3. Type in **www.wastetracker.sa.gov.au** and click **Add** then **Close**:



4. Refresh the WasteTracker page (F5) and login if necessary.



Google Chrome

Problem:


Pop-up Blocker: Usually if nothing happens, for example, when printing a transport certificate, a prompt will appear at the top or bottom of the screen. Users can allow the pop-ups for this site and the browser will remember not to block pop-ups from WasteTracker.

Resolution:

1. Click on the “Always allow pop-us from www.wastetracker.sa.gov.au” option

OR

2. Select [Settings](#) then [Settings > Show advanced settings > Privacy > Content Settings > Pop-ups > Manage exceptions](#) from browser menu in the top ribbon
3. Type in <http://www.wastetracker.sa.gov.au> and click [Allow](#) then [Done](#):



4. Refresh the WasteTracker page (F5) and login if necessary.



Mozilla Firefox

Problem:



Resolution:


1. Left-click on the “Always Allow on this site” option

OR

2. Select *Options* then *Content Tab > Exceptions next to the Block pop-up windows* from browser menu in the top ribbon



3. Type in www.wastetracker.sa.gov.au and click *Allow* then *Save Changes*:



4. Refresh the WasteTracker page (F5) and login if necessary.
